

The Hall

The hall is 25 x 24 meters and the course is 20 x 20 meters.



Rules for the hall

- Only dogs participating in the championship have access
- Only judges and secretaries can bring drinks in the hall itself
- When you and your dogs need liquid, please leave the hall. Drinks are allowed in the adjoining room. The ONLY exception is the warm up area, where drinking is allowed. The warm up area may be used by the team entering the ring after the team in the ring
- You may take the leash of the dog in the warm up area and going from there to the ring.
- Please do not use any toys or other equipment making noise (e.g. squeaking toys or clickers), which could disturb the team on the course.
- Please use indoor shoes it is not allowed to use outdoor shoes in the hall. Remember a towel so you can dry your dog in case of bad weather.
- There is not much room for spectators, so chairs will not be allowed in the hall
- You can walk the dogs on the grass in front of the hall the field on the other side of the road, and behind the hall must not be used. We take for granted that you clean up after your dog everywhere on the area.
- There is no possibility to buy food or drink on site. Participants will have the opportunity to get free coffee, tea and water which can be enjoyed in the adjoining room. There will also be snacks on the tables for participants and officials.
- Dogs in heat may only enter the hall just before their start in the ring and must wear pants everywhere in the hall.
- The temperature in the hall will be around 16-17°
- The floor in the hall is covered completely in agility matting. It is non-slip, and has outstanding shock absorbing qualities
